- This Entry Form together with remittance confirmation of £20.00 must be received by: Mr. Mark Evans 7 Alexandra Road Merthyr Tydfil CF47 9AA or emailed to: gcgujuniors@gmail.com NO LATER THAN MONDAY 6th APRII 2025
- 2. AGE: A Competitor must be under 18 years of age on the 1st January 2025.
- DRESS: The Committee of the Association expect all competitors to conform to acceptable standards of dress both on and off the course.
 Failure to do so could result in a player being asked to leave the course and subsequent disqualification from the Championship.
- CADDIES: Caddies are not allowed. Except in the case of physical disability & prior agreement from the Championship Chairman.
 Fore caddies are not permitted.
- 5. **START TIMES:** These can be viewed on the GlamorganGolf Website Junior Page.
- LIABILITY: All competitors are reminded that neither the SWBGA nor the host club can be held responsible for any personal property. Competitors are advised to arrange their own insurance to include public liability.
- 7. DMDS: In all SWBGA competitions a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 4-3a, for which the penalty for the first breach is General Penalty, for second breach it is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

The SWBGA request that Parents, Relatives, and Spectators keep an appropriate distance (25metres) behind the players at all times and must not communicate with a player.

If the Championship is oversubscribed then a ballot of the highest handicap competitors will take place immediately after the closing date for entries.

The handicap submitted at the time of entry will be used.

All unsuccessful entrants will be notified without delay, thereafter, but will be given the opportunity to compete if scratchings subsequently occur.

Entrance fees will be refunded to entrants balloted out and who do not compete.
